External Transport

As you would expect from a college sited in the heart of England, the college has links with all forms of transport. Rail services from nationwide arrive in Leamington Spa frequently. The motorway network makes travel from elsewhere in the UK quick and easy.

For those travelling from greater distances the superb rail links connect to major ferry ports. If you are travelling by air Birmingham International Airport is just 30 minutes drive from the College, with Heathrow, Luton, Gatwick and East Midlands airports within easy reach.

Directions

Moreton Morrell is about seven miles south of Warwick and Leamington just off the Fosse Way.

M40 travellers from the South-East use Exit 13, turn left at the top of the slip road (please travel cautiously as this is a very short slip road. Please note it is not possible to exit at Junction 13 southbound. Take the 2nd right signposted to Moreton Morrell. Continue through the village of Moreton Morrell (approx 1.5 miles from the turning off the main road. Once through the village passing the village church on your right, continue up the hill. The main college entrance is on your right at the top of the hill. All visitors should use the first or second entrance to the tier parking on the left off the drive, and should proceed to Reception which is found under the Clock Tower, and on the right under the archway into Cotswold Court.

M40 travellers from the North-West use Exit 14, follow the signs for Gaydon along the A452, go over the motorway onto the B4100, turn right on the roundabout on the Fosse Way, take the second right, then the first right.

From the M1 and the North take the M69 to Coventry and follow the by-pass signs to Warwick. Stay on the A46 to the big roundabout over the motorway and take the slip road onto the M40 towards London and immediately take Exit 14, as above.

From the West Country or Wales take the M5, the M42 and the M40.

From Cirencester follow the Fosse Way until you reach the College signs.

From Stratford cross the bridge over the River Avon and immediately turn left through Tiddington. Follow the road through Wellesbourne (towards Kineton) and turn left on leaving the village following the sign posts for Moreton Morrell.
